

## DORM HOUSING INFORMATION

IGLFA 2009 Washington has partnered with Trinity Washington University to provide discounted dorm housing for our budget conscious players and guests. The rate is \$85 for single or double occupancy. Rooms contain two separate beds, two closets, two desks, and one dresser.

### Complimentary Amenities

- \* central air conditioning

- \* shuttle service to and from metro



Guests will have access to the university's athletic facilities – indoor pool, indoor walking track, weight room, hot tub, spa, and tennis courts. The cost is \$5 for a day pass or \$10 for the week. Guests also have access to the dining hall, which offers an all you can eat breakfast buffet for \$7.32.

### Location

Trinity Washington University is in Washington DC's Brookland neighborhood. It's a quieter section of the city, in the northeast quadrant, and Trinity is directly across the street from Catholic University of America and the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. Other neighborhood landmarks include the Lincoln Cottage, the Zora Neale Hurston House, and the Mount St. Sepulchre Franciscan Monastery.

### Local Transportation

The nearest metro station to Trinity is Brookland Station, on the Red Line, which connects directly to Union Station, Dupont Circle, the event host hotel in Woodley Park, and Shady Grove Station, where players will go to be taken to the fields for preliminary matches. Trinity operates a free shuttle between the campus and Brookland Station. Service runs every 20 minutes from 7am until midnight Monday through Thursday and from 7am until 2am on Friday and Saturday. Walking to the metro station takes less than 10 minutes. A cab ride from Trinity to Dupont Circle takes about 15 minutes with fare and tip coming to around \$12.

### Reservations & Payment

IGLFA Washington organizers have reserved 40 rooms which will be available on a first come first served basis. The reservation deadline is Thursday, May 12th, 2009.
